b. **Secretary/Treasurers report** – presented by Dr Tasha Mackie

- Refer to website AUDITED FINANCIAL REPORT for the Year ended 31st December 2020.
 - COVID-19 impacted on the finances of the academy and the cancellation of the One Day meeting and the postponement of the Three-Day meeting to 2022.
 - Loss from cancelling the One Day Meeting in Melbourne approx. \$8,000. Member refunds approx. \$22,000.
 - Due to the early decision to postpone the Three-Day Meeting in Queenstown from March 2021 to March 2022, the deposits paid have been carried over without any charges. If we have to cancel the 2022 meeting, we stand to lose approx. \$45,000.
 - Current bank balance is approx. \$758,000
 - Additional Secretariat hours logged due to increased council meetings and tasks along with new website project.
 - Donation owing to APRF. A pledge donation to the UQ Research Project \$7,500.

Dr Tasha Mackie proposed a motion to keep P&Y Accountants Seconded by Dr Kaye Kendall.

Prof Ivan Darby and Dr Kaye Kendall thanked Dr Tasha Mackie for her role as Secretary /Treasurer.

iv. Social Media & Information Technology Committee (A/Prof. Tino Mercado)

- Refer to Social & Information Technology Report 2021
 - Social Media platforms have been a critical part of communication and a source of proper guidelines to members during the COVID crisis.
 - There is a new What's App Group for our Post Graduates, keeping them all connected.
 - Revamping the website in two components; Patients component and Members component.
 - The Patient component will have articles written by our members on topics at 'the patient level'. Keywords will take patients to that particular topic on our new website eg Why are my gums bleeding?
 - Need a new, modern logo to match the updated website. Tino discussed the current logo and website along with two new logo options as presented in the slideshow. Members will receive a survey in the next week to choose their preferred logo option.
 - Question from VIC: Why change the logo?
 Answer: With the upgrading of the website, we need a logo that is modern and suits the new website design/them. The current logo has served us well but is now outdated, it was developed in the 1980's.
 - Ivan Darby suggested (based on the feedback from VIC) council first send a survey to the membership asking the question to change the logo or not? It was agreed for council to review this and to update the membership.
 - Question from WA: Keywords eg 'implants' can be very expensive.
 Council will investigate keywords and SEO, being mindful of the costs involved.
